## **SECTION 25. NOTICES**

Two public information meetings in accordance with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection rules (06-096 CMR 2) and the Maine Land Use Planning Commission rules (04-061 Chapter 4) were held in Mars Hill, Maine. The first meeting on November 12, 2014, was attended by 35 people and the second meeting on March 4, 2015, was attended by 31 people.

The Notices were each mailed and published as a combined Notice of Intent to File and Notice of Public Meeting. For the meeting on November 12, 2014, the Notice was published on October 31, 2014 in the *Bangor Daily News*, on November 5, 2014 in *The Pioneer Times* in Houlton, and on November 5, 2014 in *The Star Herald* in Presque Isle (Exhibit 25-A). For the meeting on March 4, 2015, the Notice was published on February 18, 2015 in the *Bangor Daily News*, in *The Pioneer Times* in Houlton, and in *The Star Herald* in Presque Isle (Exhibit 25-B).

A copy of each Notice was sent to all abutters on October 31, 2014, on February 18, 2015, and on Tuesday, July 14, 2015. Notice was also sent to legislators whose districts encompass the Project, to the Aroostook County Commissioners, and to the town offices in the municipalities where the Project is located. In addition to these public information meetings, the Applicant held 6 open house meetings during project development. On November 12, 2013, a meeting was held at Central Aroostook High School, in Mars Hill, Maine, and was advertised via flyers posted in public spaces in communities surrounding the Project. In May through August 2014, 5 additional meetings were held in Bridgewater, Monticello, Littleton, Houlton, and Linneus. These meetings were advertised in local newspapers and postcards were distributed (Exhibit 25-E).

As required by Public Law 2011, Chapter 682, notice to the Land Use Planning Commission is being provided concurrently with the filing of this application (Section 31, Exhibit 31-A).





## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING AND INTENT TO FILE

Please take notice that Number Nine Wind Farm, LLC (the “Applicant”), a subsidiary of EDPR, with offices at 541 Main Street, Suite B, Presque Isle, Maine 04769 207-760-7210 intends to file a combined Natural Resources Protection Act (NRPA) and Site Location of Development permit application, pursuant to the provisions of 38 M.R.S.A. §§ 480-A et seq. and 38 M.R.S.A. §§ 481-490, respectively, and related regulations. This application will be filed with the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). The Applicant will also be seeking a Section 401 Water Quality Certification pursuant to 33 U.S.C § 1341. The Applicant intends to file the combined permit application on or before December 5, 2014.

The Applicant will hold a public informational meeting for the project on Wednesday, November 12, 2014 from 6pm to 8pm at Central Aroostook High School Gym, 26 Pleasant Street, Mars Hill, Maine 04758.

The purpose of the meeting is to educate the public about the project and the regulatory process, to seek public comment on the proposed application, and to educate the public about the opportunities for public comment to the Department during the application process.

The Applicant is proposing the Number Nine Wind Farm (the “proposed project”) in Aroostook County, Maine. The proposed project includes up to 125 turbines, capable of generating up to 250 megawatts of electricity, in T10 R3 WELS, T9 R3 WELS, T8 R3 WELS, TC R2 WELS, TD R2 WELS, and E Twp. The proposed project would also include: access to the turbines utilizing existing and new roads; 34.5 kilovolt (kV) electrical collector lines among the turbines and connecting to a new project substation in T9 R3 WELS; 345 kilovolt (kV) electrical generator lead line in T9 R3 WELS, T8 R3 WELS, TC R2 WELS, Hammond, Littleton, Houlton, Hodgdon, Linneus, TA R2 WELS, Forkstown Twp, and Haynesville connecting to a new substation in Haynesville; an operations and maintenance building in T9 R3 WELS; and up to 3 permanent meteorological towers.

The Site Location permit application will include a request, pursuant to 12 M.R.S.A. § 685-B(1-A)(B-1), that the Land Use Planning Commission (Commission) certify to the Department that the development is an allowed use in the subdistricts in which it is proposed and that the development will comply with applicable Commission land use standards that are not considered in the Department’s review.

The Site Location and NRPA application, including the request for certification, will be filed for public inspection at the Department’s office in Bangor and the Commission’s office in Ashland during normal working hours. # For Silver, giving back is worth its weight in gold

PRESQUE ISLE — While last Tuesday's court session at Presque Isle High School may have been "business as usual" for

his peers on the bench, it was a trip back in time for the Hon. Warren Silver, associate justice of the Maine Supreme Court. Silver graduated from PIHS in 1966.

"I love coming back to Presque Isle, and I love reconnecting with this high school. Even though I do come up here, I haven't been in this high school in years, and it brings back a lot of memories ...

all good memories. I loved going to school here," said Silver. "I met with several of the teachers last week, and I'm so impressed by them. They're a bright, energetic group and the kids are lucky to have them."

On Oct. 23, Silver visited the school where he spoke to 7-8 classes about "the judicial system, how it works, what we do as an appellate court, careers in law, and how my career has gone."

"I probably spent time with a couple hundred kids by the time the day was over. It means a lot to me to be able to do that," he said. "I think aspirations are a really important thing, and kids should start to think about what they want to do, so the way I can give back is to talk to them about my life, my path and how they could have the same kind of path ... how any kid from Presque Isle can go do anything they want to do. I believe in that strongly, and that's why I do it. I think it's a good thing when alumni come

back and participate with the kids. Recognizing that the Court has been traveling to high schools throughout the state for 10 years, Silver said the PIHS visit was their 36th high school.

"What's significant about that for me is — obviously — it's my alma mater, but it's also my last high school because I'm retiring from the court in December," he said. "We started with Caribou in 2005 and I'm ending with PIHS."

With no specific plans made for his retirement, Silver said he hopes to return to the Star City. "The first few months I'm going to be in Florida; we have a place in Sarasota and I'll spend the winter there figuring out what I'm going to do next," he said. "I'll do something, I just don't know what."

"My wife and I have established a scholarship fund at the University of Maine for kids from Aroostook County. I want to do anything I can to promote

kids from The County going to school and doing things that we need as a society that will benefit us all," said Silver. "I would love to work with the schools. I've been invited back to PIHS to do more, and I recently got an invitation to go to Easton High School. I want to do things with kids to motivate them and get them to do good things in life. I'm also a road biker and I'd like to do some biking up here."

Silver was appointed to the Court by Gov. John E. Baldacci in 2005. In addition to PIHS, he is a graduate of Tufts University. He received his law degree from the Washington College of Law at American University in 1973, and opened his private practice in Bangor in 1977. In addition to an active trial practice, Silver served on the Board of Governors, was president of the Maine Trial Lawyers Association and was chair of the Court's Civil Rules Committee and the Governor's Judicial Selection Committee.

chance for students who may want to get into that profession to see what kind of questions they'll have to answer and what kind of issues they'll have to deal with. It was awesome."

Senior Kyle Nadeau said he appreciated seeing an actual case — not a fictitious one.

"I thought it was really cool how it was a real-life case, it wasn't set up as a mock trial. We get our civics class our sophomore year, so we get an understanding of the legal system and how it works, but for them to come here, really builds on that," Nadeau said.

"Plus it shows us how the 'real world' works, and how things aren't as easy as sometimes people think they are. It was a great experience to see and be a part of."

While interesting for the students, the Oct. 28 session was particularly meaningful for the Hon. Warren Silver, associate justice of the Maine Supreme Court, as he graduated from PIHS in 1966.

"I am a proud native of Presque Isle," said Silver, who now resides in Bangor. "I was born in the hospital where city hall is now, and went to a nursery school

across the street from that hospital.

"I don't get back here as much as I'd like because I don't have family here anymore," he said. "However, I come up every summer for the Aroostook County Bar picnic, and then I come up occasionally for some other thing, but no where near as regularly as I would like to."

Silver said creating a real courtroom in a high school is a wonderful opportunity for students.

"These are real-life cases for the Maine Supreme Court. This is part of our October schedule; it just happens to be in a school auditorium," he said. "This is a total eye-opener for them because all they know is what they see on television. This is an appellate court which is quite different from a trial court. The evidence is already in and we look at technical issues. I think the kids learn a lot about the system, and when they watch live arguments with real lawyers and how we pepper them with real questions, they realize the degree of difficulty involved in all this. It's a good experience for them."

"I hope they get a sense for

what the Maine Supreme Court does, a little bit about how the system works, and I hope they're inspired to either become a lawyer or be more aware of what goes on legal-

ly," said Silver. "I really want kids to be involved in the system — whether it's as a legislator, a judge or a city councilor — although we'd prefer they not be defendants."

for future pavers in. Everything else — the flags, stones, benches and pavers — is in and ready. I'm planning Phase II for next year."

Phase II, he said, will consist of adding a paver stone wall inside the memorial with lights on it "so it shines on the veterans' names so you can see it at night."

"That's in the planning phase right now," Holschuh said. "I've got to see how much that's going to cost, and then we'll be holding some more fundraisers to pay for it."

The Nov. 11 dedication ceremony will feature comments from veterans of World War II, Korea, Vietnam, Persian Gulf and the War on Terrorism.

"They'll say a few words about what the memorial means to them," said Holschuh, noting that Gov. Paul LePage and the Canadian Army have been invited to attend. "We'll have the Maine Army National Color Guard present the colors, and the Fort Fairfield Middle-High School band will be playing the national anthem. One of the band members is really good on the saxophone and he'll be playing the Canadian anthem, as well."

"Because we live so close to the Canadian border, this memorial is not just for Aroostook County veterans," he said. "It's for all Maine veterans, as well as the Canadian

veterans because they support us. When we have our Memorial Day, they come over and help us; when they have their Canadian Days, we support them. It's a combination of the Canadian and U.S. memorials."

A 20-year Army veteran, Holschuh said he's "amazed" at the community's generosity.

"I can't really believe it's done. I started this two years ago, and I didn't think it would actually happen this fast. I'm still in shock. It looks so much different in real life than it does on a piece of paper. I still can't believe it's there on the ground right now," he said. "Words can't explain what this means to me. This is like our war memorial in Washington, D.C., but in Aroostook County."

"It's good to see Aroostook County citizens have that much respect for the veterans to donate and support every fundraiser that we did and raise the money to do this," said Holschuh, an Ohio native who retired to Maine three years ago. "We're only an 80-member post and look at what we did. I don't think there's anything like this in Maine."





## Landfills compete for demolition debris

**PRESQUE ISLE** — One man's trash is another man's treasure — or so it appeared during City Council's February meeting. City officials are hoping a change in policy with regard to the disposal of certain construction materials and a reduction of the tipping fee to \$80 will ultimately lead to increased revenue for the Presque Isle Landfill. The PIL has reportedly been losing

Landfill in Fort Fairfield, since a change in policy there allowed the mixing of debris, making disposal of construction materials easier and less costly.

Councilors discussed the issue during their monthly meeting on Feb. 2.

"I have two recommendations: one is a policy issue about demolition material and the sorting of wood, the other is reducing the tipping fee for anyone coming to the landfill

Manager Jim Bennett.

In a memo to councilors Bennett explained, "We have recently been made aware of a policy change at Tri-Community Landfill that is having an impact on the amount of waste being received at the Presque Isle Landfill. TCL used to require that all 'clean wood' be removed from construction/demolition debris (CDD) before it was landfilled. Both TCL and the PIL have had the same policy for approxi-


