KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,  
THAT I, GERTRUDE W. SORTWELL, widow, of Wiscasset, in the County of Lincoln  
and State of Maine, in consideration of one dollar and other good and val-  
uable considerations paid by ALONZO H. REED of Alna in the County of Lincoln  
and State of Maine, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby  
REMISE, RELEASE, BARGAIN, SELL AND CONVEY and forever quit-claim unto the  
said Alonzo H. Reed his heirs and assigns forever, the right to pass and re-  
pass on foot, by teams, automobiles, trucks, and otherwise to the land of  
the said Alonzo H. Reed over a strip of land two rods wide across the  
Pasture Northerly of the buildings on the Wm. D. Patterson or Averell Place,  
so called, in Alna, Maine, and said 2 rod right of way being more particular-  
ly bounded and described as follows, viz:- Beginning at a point on the Old  
Road leading by the said Patterson Place to the Old Meeting House in Alna,  
Maine, at a point sixteen feet Northwesterly of the Stone Wall separating  
the pasture from the lot on which the said Patterson or Averell house is  
located; thence Northeasterly eighteen rods, more or less, to an iron post  
to be driven in the ground; thence Northerly thirty rods, more or less, to  
a point in the line between the land of the said Sortwell and Reed that is  
twenty-six feet Westerly from the remains of an Old Stone Wall on the line  
between the said Reed and Sortwell; thence Westerly on said line between the  
said Reed and Sortwell two rods; thence Southerly keeping a distance of two  
rods from the first described line to the said Highway leading to the Old  
Meeting House in Alna, Maine.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to Alonzo H. Reed, the said Grantee, his  
Heirs and Assigns forever.
