KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, GERTRUDE W. SORTWELL, widow, of Wiscasset, in the County of Lincoln and State of Maine, in consideration of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations paid by ALONZO H. REED of Alna in the County of Lincoln and State of Maine, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby REMISE, RELEASE, BARGAIN, SELL AND CONVEY and forever quit-claim unto the said Alonzo H. Reed his heirs and assigns forever, the right to pass and repass on foot, by teams, automobiles, trucks, and otherwise to the land of the said Alonzo H.
