RE: Air Permit Application Process Logistics Questions

To the Presiding Officer and Board of Environmental Protection:

As a resident of Bayside Village in Northport, less than two miles downwind from the site of the proposed NordicAquaFarms site, I would like to address my concerns regarding the viability of the Findings of Fact/Draft Board Order for the air permit application.

The NAF industrial stacks will be significantly higher than the Belfast Planning Board Zoning Regulation allows; they will result in a significant increase of nitrogen oxide pollutants in the air for the surrounding Belfast and Northport communities; and the size of the power plant is out of proportion to any other industrial facility in the area.

NAF has intentionally misled the public and the Board of Environmental Protection by repeatedly presenting renderings of the proposed NAF facility that omit any depiction of industrial smoke stacks, when, in fact, there will be *eight* power plant stacks all exceeding the size and height limits set by the Belfast Planning Board.

Please take these points into consideration.
