Section 18. Solid Waste

A. Narrative.

During construction, there will be dumpsters on site to accommodate trash from ground equipment operators. The dumpsters will be removed after construction. A standard 55-gallon garbage bin will be on site from that point on, and the developer will be responsible for maintaining it. Following construction, there will be no major waste materials on site to dispose of aside from those inside the WTG nacelles. Regular maintenance of the WTGs will involve the handling of oil products. Each turbine will contain between 200 liters and 500 liters (53 and 130 gallons) of petroleum products, including crank case oil, grease and hydraulic fluids. All such material will be removed from the site for appropriate disposal as required.

Smaller vegetative debris will be run through a chipper and utilized for erosion control as applicable. Stumps and grubbing's will be buried within specific fill slope areas on site.
