SECTION 19 FLOODING

A. Potential Flooding Impact


Site Law standards related to flooding states that the activity will not unreasonably cause or increase the flooding of the alteration area or adjacent properties, nor create an unreasonable flood hazard to any structure (Title 38 M.R.S. § 484).

Based on a review of Federal Emergency Management Agency Flood Insurance Rate Maps, the Project does not contain any mapped flood zones or special flood hazard areas, and as such, no Project components will be constructed within any mapped 100-year flood zones. The closest Federal Emergency Management Agency-mapped floodplains to the Project (Figure 19-1) are approximately 32 mi from the nearest Project infrastructure.
