Dear Mr. Stuart-Paul and Mr. Louder:

The Department has received applications submitted by CES on behalf of Fiberight, LLC and the Municipal Review Committee, Inc. for a solid waste processing facility and associated infrastructure in Hampden. The Department received seven permitting applications associated with this project in accordance with the listing included in your June 24, 2015 transmittal letter. This is a multi-Bureau permitting effort across Land Resources, Remediation and Waste Management, and Air Quality.

Each Bureau has reviewed their relevant application submittals to determine if the applications are acceptable for processing. Based on this review, each Bureau has determined that the applications submitted are acceptable for processing. Attached to this letter please find their acceptance letters. This means that the Department can proceed with a substantive review of the applications at this time. As the Department conducts its review, there may be additional information requested from you.

The Commissioner has determined that this application is likely to require significantly more costs than the total application fees normally due to the Department, and thus has designated this application as being subject to the special fee provisions of 38 M.R.S. § 352.3. This designation applies to all of the applications submitted. Department staff will be tracking the time and expenses associated with processing the application, and you will be billed quarterly for actual costs to the Department.

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 2, Section 11.C, the guaranteed processing time for all applications submitted will correspond to the longest processing time associated with any of the applications. In this case, the longest processing time is

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associated with the Chapter 409 processing facility application, which is 365 days. This guaranteed processing time stops if the Commissioner determines that a public hearing is required, or that the applicant significantly modifies the applications.

Since this is a multi-Bureau permitting effort with multiple applications, the Department will be communicating with you in accordance with the finalized *Communications Plan* dated July 15, 2015. In order to maintain a complete and accurate project file, it is important that all parties utilize this plan. As you know, I will be serving as Project Manager to coordinate the multi-Bureau permitting effort. I encourage direct contact with the individual program licensing staff as needed as long as the *Communications Plan* is followed.

Dear Mr. Stuart-Paul and Mr. Louder:

The Department has received the application submitted by CES on behalf of Fibright, LLC and the Municipal Review Committee, Inc. for a solid waste processing facility in Hampden, and has assigned it DEP# S-022458-WK-A-N. Please refer to this number in future correspondence. The application is now in a form acceptable for processing. This means that the Department can proceed with a substantive review of the application at this time.

During the review process, other reviewers or I may uncover issues which require clarification or additional work by Fibright, MRC, or your consultant. Therefore, at this point I cannot anticipate when a final decision might be made on your application. The guaranteed processing time for this type of application is 365 days, except that the processing period stops if the Commissioner determines a public hearing is required, or that the applicant has significantly modified the application.

The Commissioner has concluded that this application is likely to require significantly more costs than the \$2210.00 total application fee, and thus has designated this application as being subject to the special fee provisions of 38 M.R.S.A. § 352.3. Department staff will be tracking the time and expenses associated with processing the application, and you will be billed for the actual costs to the Department.
