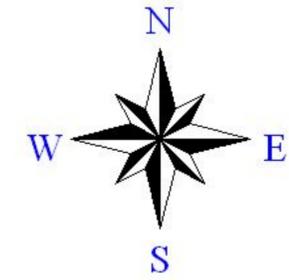




A-08-1 Irving Oil Terminal (Flood)

Strategy Implementation

- This is an Containment Configuration 2,000 feet long meant to contain a spill from the terminal or a vessel at the dock.
1. Establish communications with Command Center.
 2. Use Boom from Irving boom trailer or PRC barge.
 3. Use river current to assist deployment.
 4. Attach one end of each section to an anchor point in the channel adjacent to the unloading hoses.
 5. Attach other end to a tree on the shore to the left of the base ball park through the woods.
 6. Observe deployment for stability.
 7. Prepare to recover oil?

East on Woodbury Ave to left onto Market Street, just past Merriot left onto Kearsarge Way, Bare right on to Ranger Way to left onto Preble Way park near baseball park west of the route 93 bridge Up river flood tide anchor point is to the left of the park through the woods Irving Gate & Office on the other side of the bridge is first Building on left.
