




<b>Strategy Implementation</b>	Use three 600 foot lengths of harbor boom to cascade across river to property with retaining wall on Maine side.		
<b>Site Access</b>	Hilton Park boat ramp: On Route 16, Dover Point, NH. Eliot boat ramp (mid to high tide only): Off Route 103 (Main St.) to Eliot Shores Ln, Eliot, ME Maine collection area: From Eliot center, Route 103 N to River Road. Left on River Road. Site is 0.65 miles from intersection, between Riverview Drive and Foxbrush Drive.		
<b>Staging Areas</b>	Hilton Park Boat Ramp (mid and high tide only) and/or from private property on Maine side.		
<b>Collection Points</b>	From private property on Maine side (see Site Access)		
<b>Environmental Concerns</b>	Upper Piscataqua has shorebird habitat, shellfish areas, diadromous fish runs, bald eagles
