



A-38-1 Isles of Shoals

Strategy Implementation

To contain a spill from a heating oil tank on the island.
Use the boom to contain the oil near the island and prevent it from escaping.
Boom off Babb's Cove on Appledore Island or,
Boom off Southwest side of Star Island.
Prepare to recover oil.
