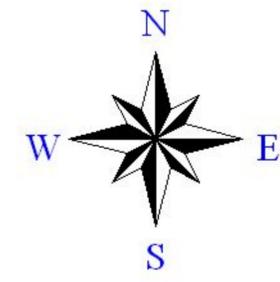



# A-47-1 Cape Porpoise Harbor (Wind from North)



<b>Strategy Implementation</b>			

This is an exclusionary configuration 3,900 feet long. There are 5 unconnected pieces between the mainland and the islands.

1. Establish communications with Command Center.
2. Use wind and current to assist deployment. Tow boom against current.
3. Deploy 1,100 feet between Nessler Point & Cape Porpoise.
4. Deploy 800 feet between Cape Porpoise & eastern point of Redin Island.
5. Deploy 600 feet between Redin Island anchor point above & the northern end of Trott Is.
6. Deploy 900 feet between southern point of Trott Island and Goat Island.
7. Deploy 500 feet between Eastern Point of Trott Island & Cape Island.
8. Observe deployment for stability.
9. Prepare to recover oil

<b>Site Access</b>	From Route 9 in Kennebunkport, turn east onto Pier Road to Cape Porpoise town wharf.
