Strategy Implementation	<p>1st Section: Approx. 550' of harbor boom deployed with onshore end secured to the cribstone dock support at the tip of Stockbridge Point and the offshore end adjacent to "#7" green can. 2nd Section: Approx. 1300' of harbor boom anchored in vicinity of green can #7, to Moore Point. Collection at houses on shoresides of boom.</p>		
Site Access	From Exit 17, Maine Turnpike, north on Rte. 1 to South Freeport Road, right on Main St. to Brewer's Marina.		
Staging Areas	Brewer's Marina, South Freeport Town Landing		
Collection Points	Houses on landward ends of boom.		
Environmental Concerns	Salt marsh at upper end of Harraseeket River. Extensive shellfish beds. Diadromous fish and elver runs in river. Shorebird area. Aquaculture sites and lobster dealer.
