
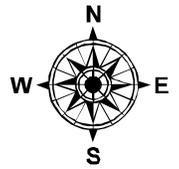

St George / South Thomaston





Length of Boom	5150	feet <i>Unless otherwise indicated, the boom length given is straight line distance as measured on the map. Actual length required will vary with conditions, and increase with current.</i>	
Strategy Implementation	<p>If ocean boom is available, close off Seal Harbor with five 700 foot lengths. Place 150 feet of harbor boom across causeway to Sprucehead Island. Deploy 1500 feet of harbor boom from Rackliff Island to Sprucehead Island to protect inner area of harbor. Possible collection at Spruce Head Fisherman's Co-op float on Wharf Street. Use open water skimming.</p>		
Site Access	Route 1 to Rockland, Route 73 to South Thomaston		
Staging Areas	South Thomaston boat launch or Spruce Head Fisherman's Co-op		
Collection Points	Spruce Head Fisherman's Co-op Float or open water recovery.		
Environmental Concerns	Shellfish areas, shorebird habitat, extensive eelgrass, lobster pounds and dealers. Numerous seabird nesting islands in vicinity.
