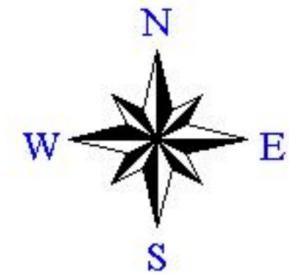



C-51-1 Duck Cove
