- ✓ A map or schematic of the treatment area showing treatment and monitoring location(s)
- ✓ A statement demonstrating the date and location of the public informational meeting as described in Special Condition G.3 of the General Permit.
- ✓ Copies of the published Notice of Intent to File and a list of abutters to whom notice was provided in accordance with Special Condition D.3 of the General Permit
