


State Poverty Rate: Population Living in Poverty


Elder Population Rate: Population Age 65 or Older


Disability Population Rate: Maine Adults with a Disability


TANF Benefit Rate: Maine People Receiving TANF


Chronic Disease Rates: Overall Cancer Incidence


Chronic Disease Rates: Diabetes Prevalence among Maine Adults


Chronic Disease Rates: Maine Adults with Asthma


Chronic Disease Rates: Maine Children and Youth with Asthma


Chronic Disease Rates: Major Cardiovascular Disease Deaths






















Children and Youth in DHHS-OCFS Custody






Maine One-Year-Old Children with Elevated Lead Levels














Placements for Children in DHHS Custody




Nutrition: Maine Residents who Receive Food Supplement
































**Nursing Facility Quality of Care:


**Nursing Facility Quality of Care:




**Nursing Facility Quality of Care:


