1915 (B) WAIVERS ARE CALLED FREEDOM OF CHOICE WAIVERS. THE STATE IS ALLOWED TO WAIVE: MANAGED CARE, A CARVE-OUT DELIVERY SYSTEM, ENHANCED SERVICE PACKAGE OR STATEWIDENESS.

1915 (C) WAIVERS ALLOW INSTITUTIONAL LEVEL OF CARE IN A COMMUNITY SETTING. THE STATE IS ALLOWED TO WAIVE INCOME LEVELS, ALLOWS SERVICES TO EXTEND BEYOND STATE PLAN LEVELS, AND MUST BE COST NEUTRAL. (THIS MEANS THIS MAY NOT COST MORE THAN IF THE MEMBER HAD RECEIVED THESE SERVICES IN AN INSTITUTION.)

SOME WAIVERS CALCULATE COST NEUTRALITY ON AN AGGRAGATE BASIS PER MEMBER THAN ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS.

THE IMPACT IF THESE WAIVERS DID NOT EXIST: MAINE'S WAIVERS ARE FOR MEMBERS WHO REQUIRE INSTITUTIONAL LEVEL OF CARE, NURSING FACILITY, HOSPITAL OR INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITIES (ICR-MRs). WITHOUT THESE WAIVERS, CMS WOULD STILL REQUIRE MAINECARE TO COVER SERVICES FOR THESE MEMBERS. THESE MEMBERS WOULD MOST LIKELY TURN TO NURSING FACILITIES, HOSPITALS OR INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITIES. PRESENTLY, THERE ARE NOT ENOUGH BEDS IN THESE FACILITIES TO ACCOMMODATE THIS POPULATION.
