- b. Maine Rural Water Association Kirsten Hebert and Tom Bahun
  - i. Concerns regarding testing vendor At Your Own Pace (AYPO).
    - 1. Claims that layout and timing of exams of courses do not reflect time spent on coursework and that courses can be taken in less time than approved at.
    - Claims that courses do not hold persons accountable for attention to coursework online.
  - ii. Solutions and Resolutions
    - 1. Jim Jacobsen will be addressing concerns with providers of online coursework.
    - 2. ABC guidance is important for seeking standardization of online courses.
    - 3. Possibility of board "scholarship" to audit coursework by different vendors.
- c. JETCC applications for course approval Greg Kidd
  - i. Cold Climate approved 2015, 6 TCHs
    - 1. Seems to be slanted toward subsurface wastewater information.
    - 2. Wants to see coursework reflect more Water Operator information especially for use with Licensure.
  - ii. Microscopic Examination approved 2018, 6 TCHs
    - 1. Majority of information slanted toward subsurface wastewater information.
    - 2. Claims coursework only spend small amount of time for Water Operator information.
  - iii. Solutions and Resolutions
    - 1. Jim Jacobsen will address issues with LeeAnn from JETCC.
- d. Discussed issues about the ABC testing sites including 10 extra fielding questions that do not count toward grade.
  - i. Some concern for test candidates causing more test anxiety.
  - ii. Proctors and test prep facilitators should inform test candidates about the +10 questions.
  - iii. ABC has changed approach to inform test candidates of the extra questions prior to taking test.
