- Assume there is lead paint in all buildings built before 1950
- Maintain painted surfaces properly. Inspect for peeling, flaking, or chalking paint every 6 months
- If you plan to renovate, repair or paint a rental property, hire an RRP-certified contractor or get certified yourself
