This two-day course is partial minimum training required for Maine radon air tester registration, and prepares you for and is a prerequisite to the National Radon Proficiency Program (NRPP) or National Radon Safety Board (NRSB) exam. You must also pass one or the other of these exams to become a registered radon air tester in Maine. Either the NRPP or NRSB exam will be made available to you after the course concludes; or you can arrange with either of those organizations to take the exam at another time. If you pass the exam, you may then apply for Maine radon air tester registration; and are eligible for certification with NRPP or NRSB. Please note: Maine requires passing the NRPP or the NRSB exam, but does not require you to become NRPP or NRSB certified.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Course and exam registrations and/or cancellations must be received at least 3 days prior to date of course whenever possible or a late cancellation fee may be charged.

Maine requires passing the NRPP or the NRSB mitigation exam, but does not require you to become NRPP or NRSB certified.
