

GlitterBug[®] RECIPE

Here is information for using GlitterBug[®] Powder to determine if high-touch areas are adequately cleaned:

2 oz. of Dish Liquid

1/2 tsp of GlitterBug[®] Powder

1 oz. of water

1/4 oz roll on bottles

Mix ingredients together. Pour into 1/4 oz roll-on bottles. Makes about 9 bottles. If you use distilled or sterile water, it should last for months.

To buy replacement GlitterBug[®] Powder and UV light.

The powder is \$5 for 2 oz., and the light costs \$20. Note: Powder is used instead of gel because gel is hard to remove and may not be an accurate reflection of cleaning done. The roll on bottles are available on E-bay. To order a 1/3 oz roll-on bottle (#200420267109), go to e-Bay. Price is \$14/bottle. Note that that recipe makes enough for 9 bottles.
