# Get Vaccinated this Summer!

Late spring and summer checkups/physicals for sports and summer camps

are a perfect opportunity to catch preteens and teenagers up with routinely recommended vaccines. In addition to the Tdap booster, the federal Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommend that adolescents receive vaccines to protect against both meningococcal (MCV4) and the human papillomavirus (HPV).

We recommend that you begin sending out reminder recall notices to patients who may be due for immunizations. The CDC also has several resources for back to school immunizations that may be shared via newsletters, emails, and social media!

## **Tdap for 7th Grade Entry**

The Maine school age immunization requirements have recently changed to include Tdap as a required vaccine for 7<sup>th</sup> grade entry. Reminder/Recall can also be used as an effective method to get your adolescent patients ready for the start of the 2017-18 school year.
