
## WESTERN DISTRICT: Environmental Health

## Private Well Water Testing

More than half of Maine's population relies on a private well for their drinking water. Many Maine wells have unsafe levels of arsenic, radon, uranium - chemicals that can cause cancer or other health effects.

Testing is the only way to know if the well water is safe to drink.

## **Public Drinking Water Systems**

Safe drinking water is essential to protecting good human health. Maine people enjoy access to excellent quality drinking water from many lakes, rivers and underground aquifers. More than 2,000 public water systems provide drinking water to over half of Maine's population and many guests.

Public water systems must comply with the federal <u>Safe Drinking Water Act</u> and state laws, including protecting drinking water sources and maintaining or improving local water system facilities. Communities can work together to protect shared drinking water sources.
