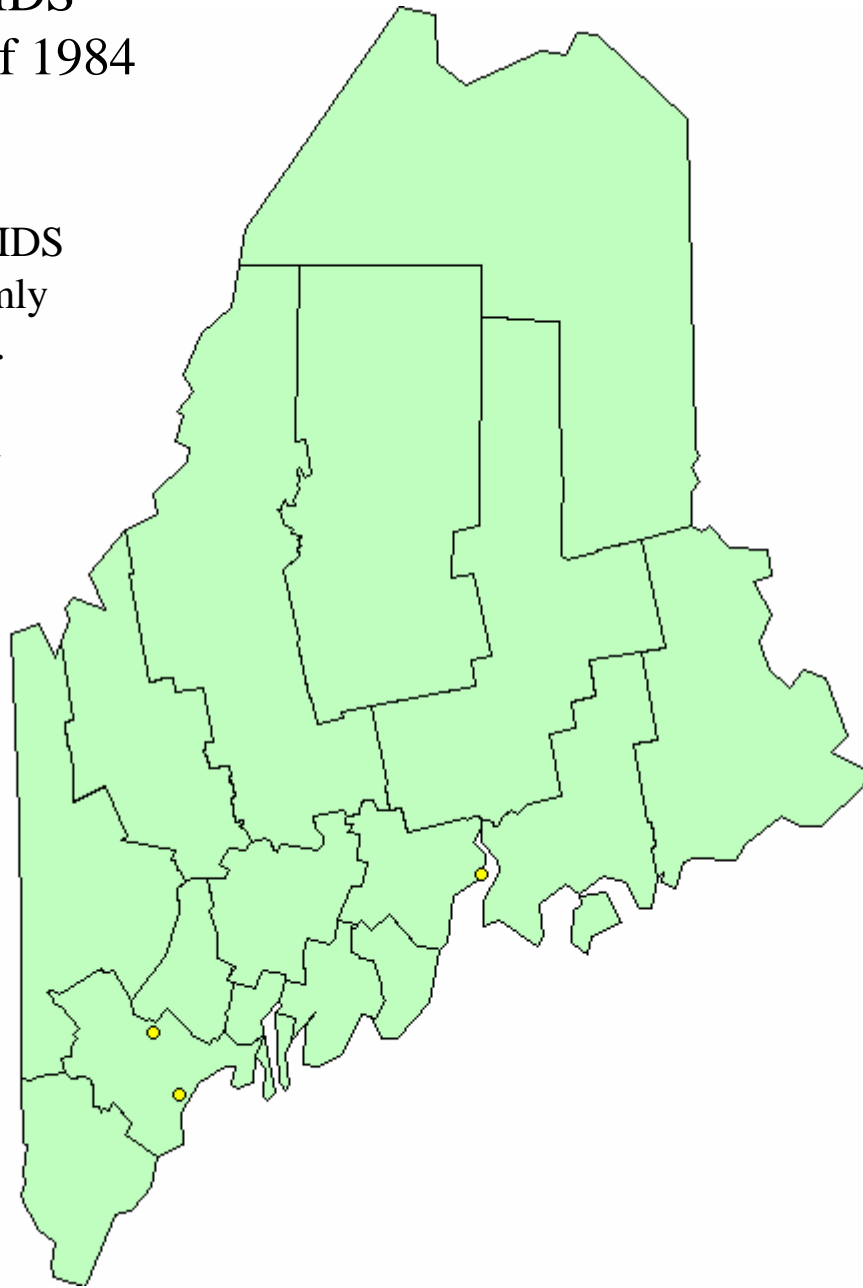


People living with AIDS

placed within each county.

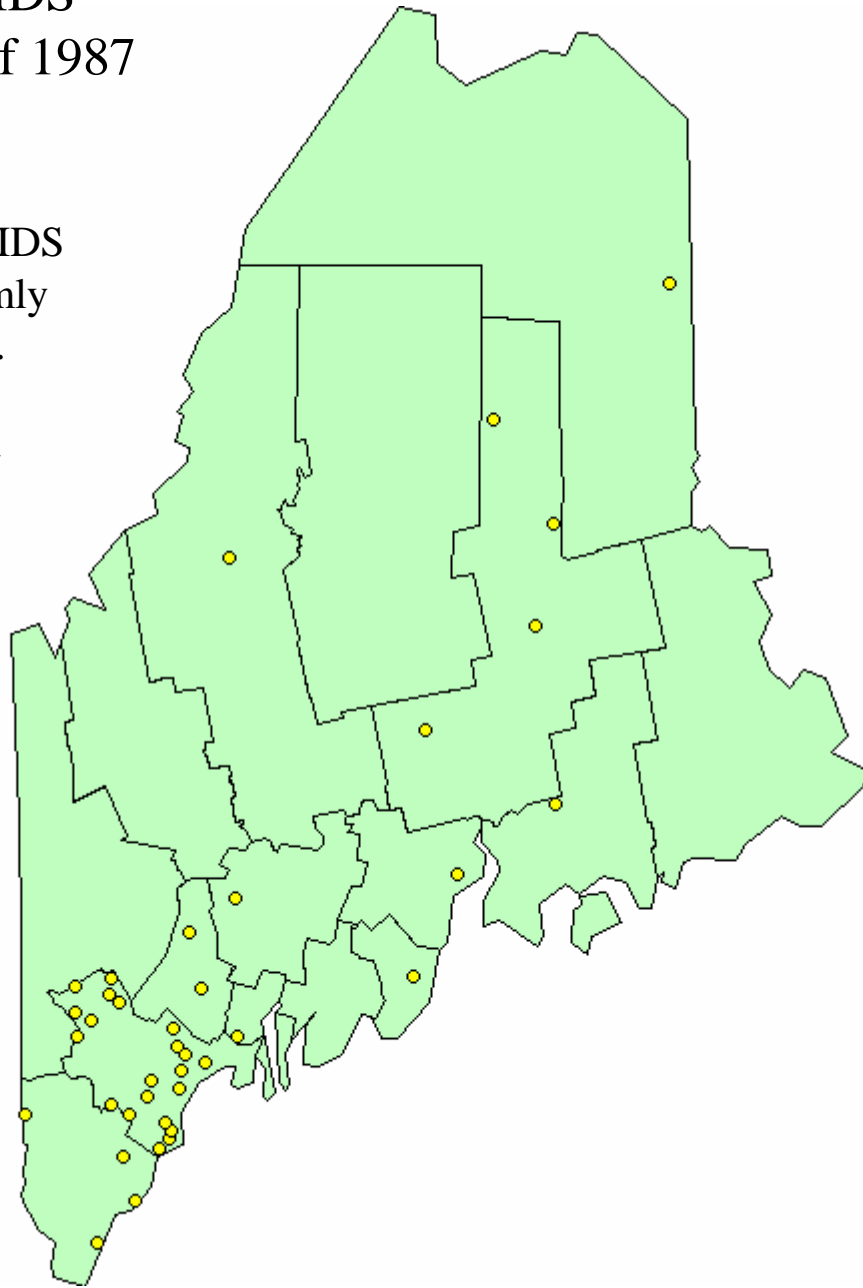

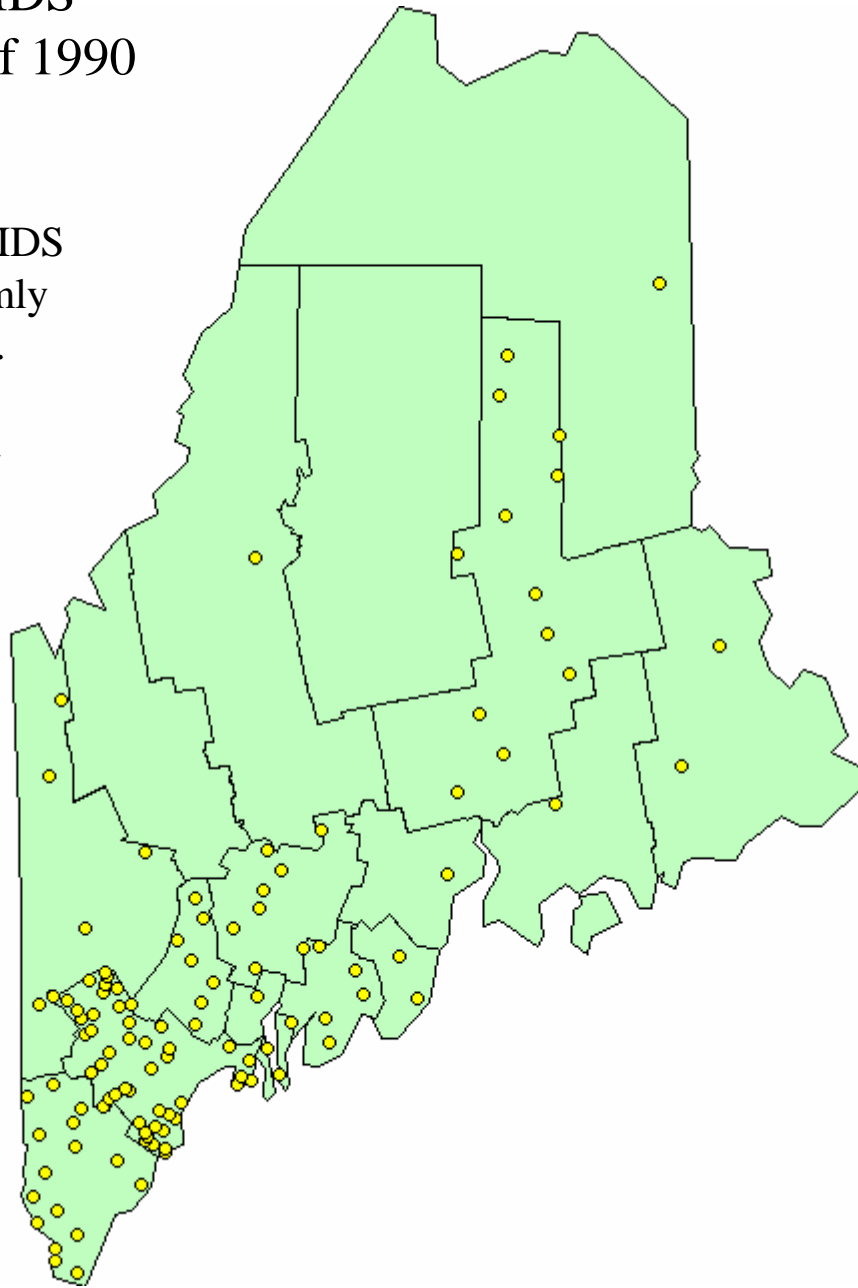

placed within each county.

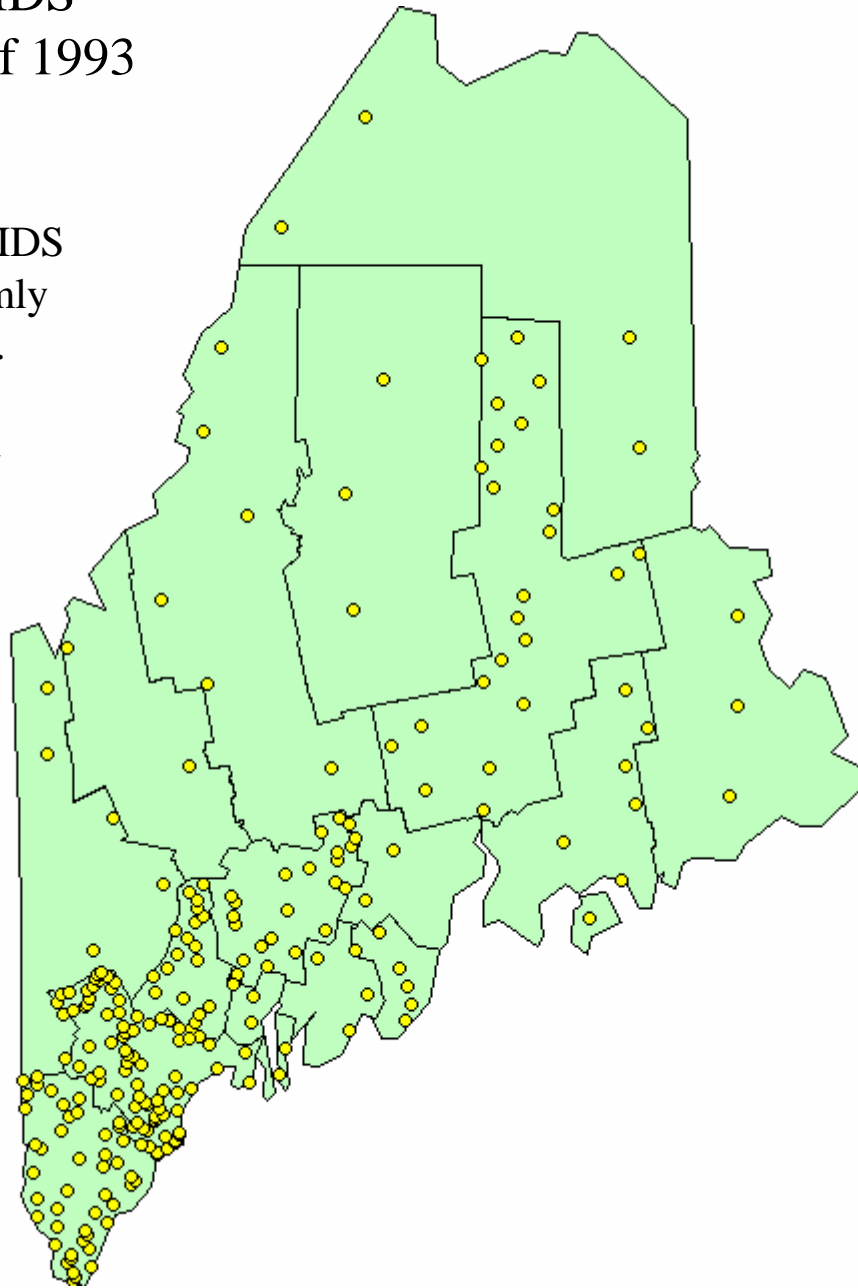

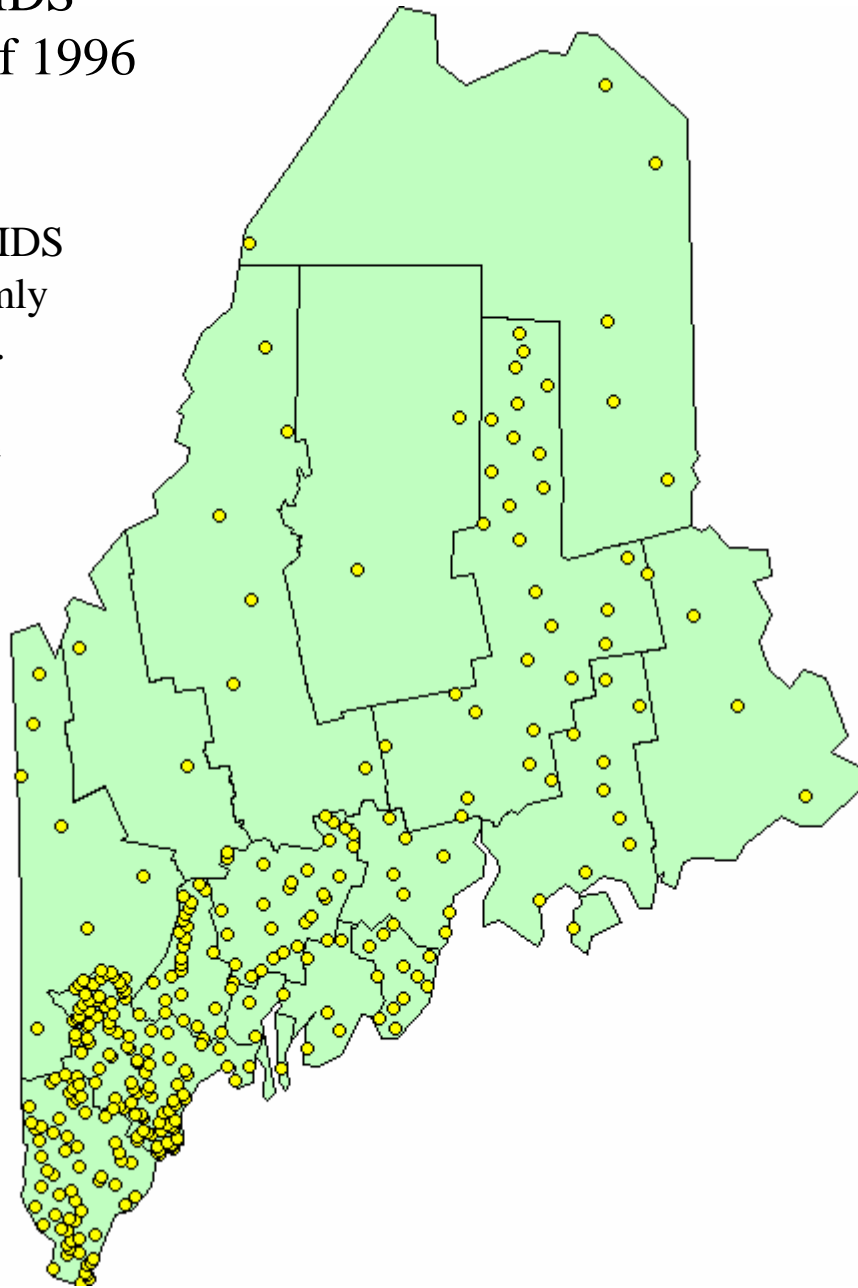

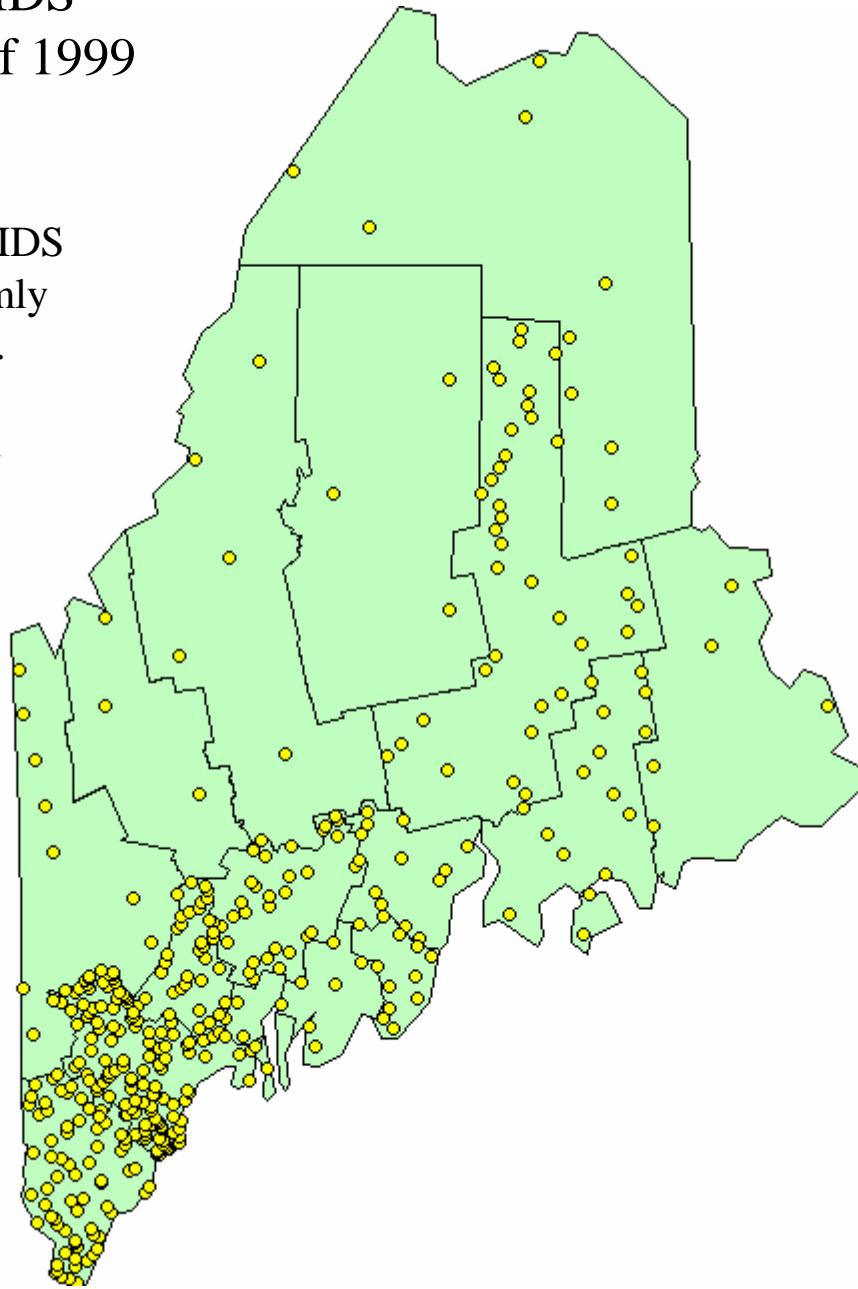

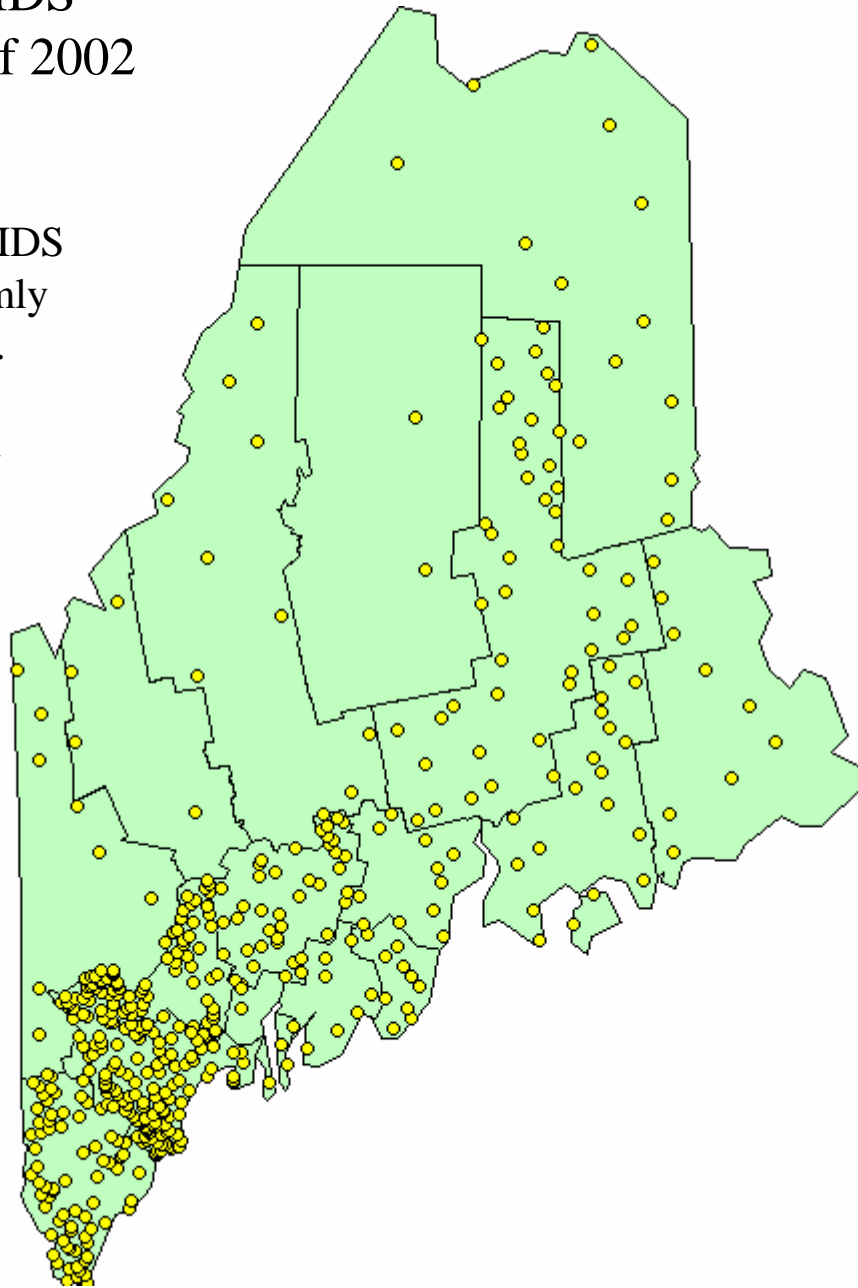

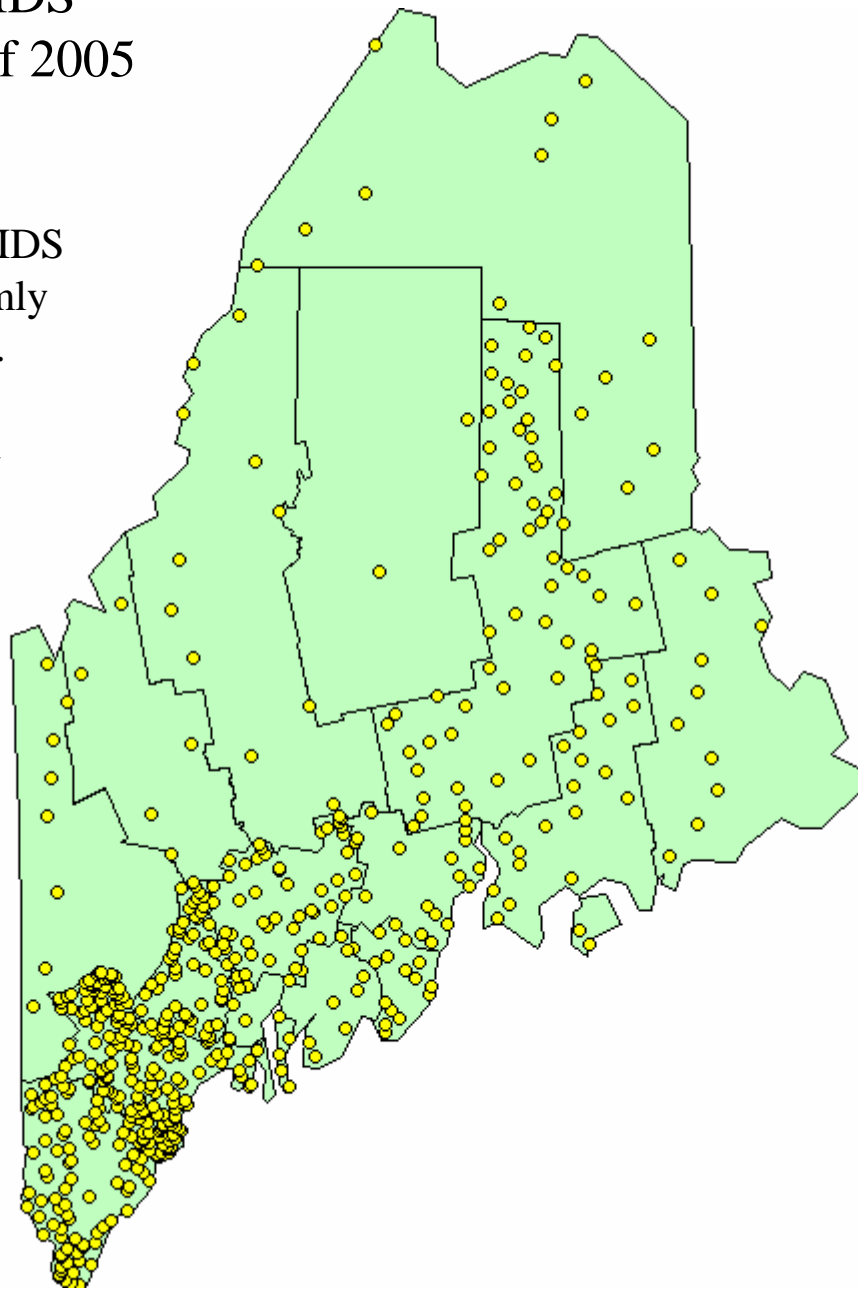

placed within each county.

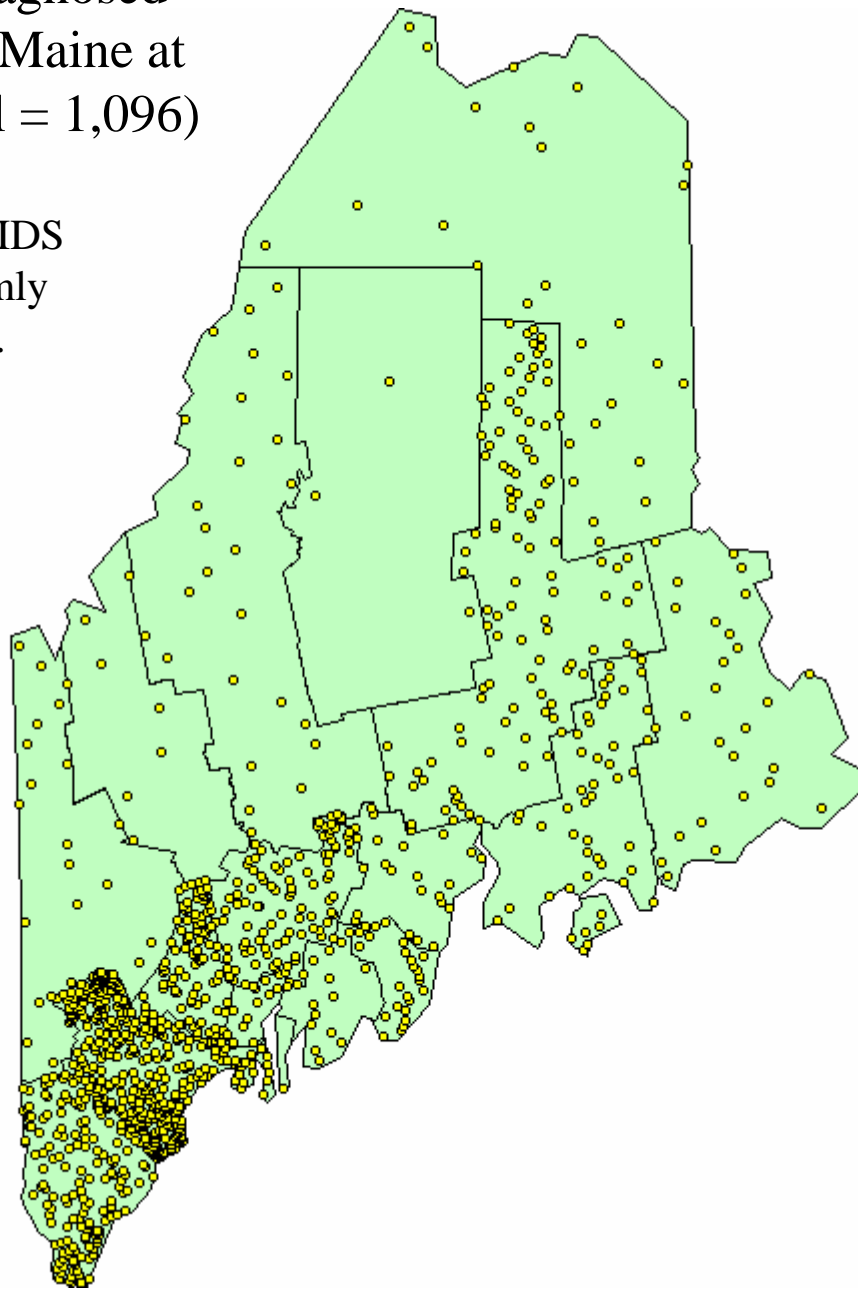
