During 2005, the Maine CDC received reports of 2,253 chlamydia diagnoses, 142 gonorrhea diagnoses and three cases of "early" (primary, secondary and early latent) syphilis. The number of chlamydia diagnoses in 2005 represents a 6% increase over the 2004 total. Far fewer gonorrhea diagnoses were reported in 2005 than were seen in 2004, with a 34% decrease noted. The three syphilis cases diagnosed in 2005 represent a slight increase over the two cases reported in 2004.

Gonorrhea was diagnosed most frequently among residents of southern and central Maine, while chlamydia diagnoses were distributed more evenly throughout the state. Men who have sex with men (MSM) were disproportionately affected by gonorrhea, accounting for roughly one-quarter of diagnoses. Chlamydia infections were most often diagnosed in young people between the ages of 15 and 24, with this age group accounting for 74% of diagnoses.
