The Maine CDC WIC Nutrition Program may provide payment for electric breast pump rentals for exclusively breastfeeding mothers under certain circumstances or to partially breastfeeding mothers for short term attempts to increase milk supply. WIC agreed to pay for an electric breast pump for you and your baby based on need and your signed agreement.

The local WIC agency has reviewed your electric breast pump rental and finds that WIC can no longer pay for the pump rental for the following reason:

- There is no more medical need
- You missed your WIC appointments and WIC staff are unable to reach you via phone or you are no longer enrolled in WIC
- Your baby has reached their first birthday
- Your baby gets more supplemental formula than is allowed
- WIC staff are unable to reach you to decide if you still need the pump rental
