## What do I need to bring to my first WIC appointment?

Women, infants and children applying for WIC must be present at the first visit. You also need to bring the following:

## **Proof of income eligibility**

If you receive MaineCare, SNAP, or TANF, you must bring:	
	MaineCare card or eligibility letter for all persons applying for WIC
	SNAP enrollment or renewal letter
	TANF statement
Income for all household members for the past 30 days. This includes, but is not limited to:	
	Pay stubs
	Military earning statements/LES
	Pay statement from employer
	Child support or alimony agreement
	SSI/SSD statement
Proof of where you live (your physical address, not a P.O. box). This	
includes, but is not limited to:	
	Utility bill in your name, matching your given address
	Mail with your name and address on it
	Driver's license with your street address
	Rental agreement or mortgage paper with your name and address
	TANF statement, MaineCare card
	SNAP enrollment or renewal letter
Proof of identification for everyone applying for WIC. This includes,
