

Maine's estimated population for July 1, 1992 is 1,236,348; this is a statewide increase of 1,751 over the 1991 statewide estimates.



- Twelve of Maine's 16 counties experienced population increases between 1991 and 1992; however, Androscoggin, Aroostook, and Penobscot counties all experienced decreases. The population of Cumberland county remained constant.
- Penobscot county, Maine's 3rd most populated county, experienced the greatest net population loss between 1991 and 1992 (783 residents). Androscoggin county had the greatest proportional drop in population (.7%).
- ► Waldo county experienced the greatest percent population increase between 1991 and 1992. The county gained more than 400 residents; a population increase of 1.2%. The numeric increase was enough to move Waldo county from being 13th in population to 12th, changing places with Sagadahoc county.
