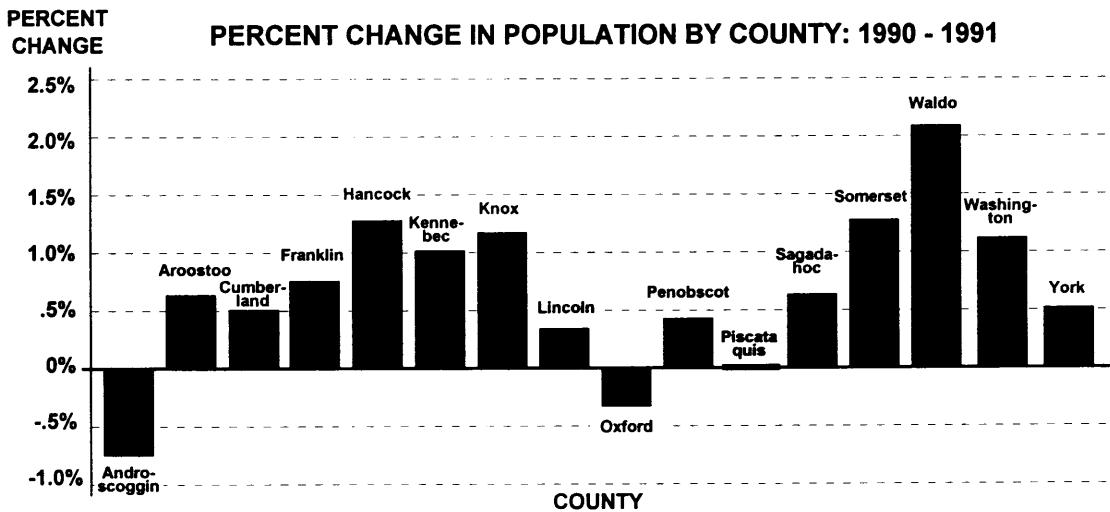
➔ Maine's estimated population for July 1, 1991 is 1,234,597; this is a statewide increase of 6,669 (.5%) over the 1990 federal census count.

➔ Thirteen of Maine's 16 counties experienced population increases between 1990 and 1991; however, Androscoggin and Oxford counties both experienced decreases. The population of Piscataquis county remained constant.

➔ Androscoggin county, Maine's 5th most populated county, experienced the greatest net population loss between 1990 and 1991 (725 residents). Population losses in Androscoggin's two largest cities (Lewiston and Auburn) of over 1,500 people accounted for the decrease; no other town or city in the county experienced a loss.

➔ Waldo county, Maine's 4th least populated county, experienced the greatest percent population increase between 1990 and 1991. The county gained almost 700 residents; a population increase of 2.1%.
