| Specimen <br> Requirements |
| :---: |
| - Cerebral Spinal Fluid (CSF) $(0.5 \mathrm{ml}$ minimum, 1 ml preferred) or serum (at least 0.5 mL$)$. <br> - Samples should be kept at $2-8^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ for short term storage and may be frozen $\left(-70^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\right)$ for long term <br> storage. Collect specimen in a sterile leak proof container. <br> - Respiratory: Nasopharyngeal swab, Throat swab, Nasal wash |


| Collection Instructions | - DO NOT DILUTE CSF. Do not use viral transport media (VTM). <br> - Respiratory specimens should be submitted in VTM or other appropriate media. <br> - Ship specimens on frozen ice packs and transport to lab as soon as possible. <br> - Do not freeze/thaw |

| Turn Around Time | -Results are generally available within 1-3 business days of specimen receipt |

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\text { Unacceptable } \quad \text { - Rejection Criteria: CSF or serum diluted in Viral Transport Media (VTM), specimen not refrigerated }
