	the complaint. Records are kept locally at the municipality. LHOs	
	work with the municipality's code enforcement, plumbing	
	inspection, and the District DL to identify any other resources that	
	may be needed (e.g., DEP, Adult/Child Protective Services, etc).	
	Question: I think your abandoned graphic would be helpful for	
	LHOs. We're working on a resource guide template for ours that
