LICENSING PROCESS STEP BY STEP:

Download an application at maine.gov/healthinspection under Forms and Applications.

Mail your application and payment to Augusta at least 30 days before you plan to operate.

Ensure your application is complete; incomplete submissions will not be processed.

A health inspector will contact you to schedule an appointment



WHAT HAPPENS ONCE I AM LICENSED?

You will receive your license in the mail along with an ID number and PIN for online renewal at maine.gov/online/hipicensing.
