LEAD SERVICE LINE INVENTORY ASSISTANCE GRANT

Lead Service Line Inventory Assistance Grants.

Since the State of Maine has opted not to request the Lead Service Line (LSL) replacement funds during the 2022 funding cycle, a grant fund has been set up using the 15% Set-aside for stop gap funding of lead service line inventory activities. Grants will be offered on a rolling basis to all Community and Non-Community Non-Transient Public Water Systems until the \$600,000 of 2022 grant funds are expended. Grants will be reimbursement for 50% of the approved cost of services not to exceed \$8.00 per service connection.

If I am awarded a grant, how do I get reimbursed?

First, complete your project. Then, by July 1, 2023, submit a request for reimbursement with the following: 1. A copy of the letter of agreement or contract between the water system and the selected firm providing the assistance; 2. Copies of all paid invoices for reimbursable costs.

Can I get a project extension?

A water system may apply for one project extension, for up to 6 months, by calling (207) 274-9003. If a project is not completed by the date approved in the grant or extension, the water system forfeits the grant award. Additionally, a water system may request an extension up front, if it is anticipated the project will take longer than the time allotted. Please indicate this on your application.
