#### **Demographics:**



- 63% of patients were male
- 61 years old on average
- 100% of patients were White
- 93% of patients were Not-Hispanic, 7% unknown

## How it spreads:

- People get Legionnaires' Disease when they breathe in small droplets of water containing Legionella bacteria
- People can not spread Legionella to other people

- · People 50 years or older
- Current or former smokers
- · People with chronic lung disease
- · People with weak immune systems or who take drugs that weaken the immune system
- People with cancer
- People with underlying conditions such as diabetes, kidney failure, or liver failure
