To Parents or Guardians of Children Receiving
 Health Home and Targeted Case Management Services

As you may know, your child was enrolled in the Health Home program at his/her primary care practice. This program helps MaineCare members who have health needs that last a long time. Your child got these services based on his/her health care needs. Health Homes work with Community Care Teams (CCT) to provide care coordination, referrals, and other services. Your child receives CCT services as part of the Health Home program.

Your child is now also eligible for Targeted Case Management (TCM) services. TCM also provides care coordination, referrals, and similar services. Your child cannot get both Health Home/CCT services and TCM services at the same time.

MaineCare has asked your child's providers to help you decide which service best meets your child's needs. Please note that your child's primary care provider will not change with either service that you choose.

Please check one of the following:

I choose to have my child continue to be enrolled in the Health Home program and receive services from the CCT. I do not wish to have my child receive TCM services at this time. I understand that my child can continue to see his/her primary care provider.
