

Legal Notice Certificate of Need

Public Hearing

The Maine Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) announces that an application for a Certificate of Need (CON) has been received and certified as complete by the applicant. DHHS, CONU, has scheduled a public hearing on Rousseau Management, Inc.'s proposal to build a replacement nursing facility for Amenity Manor in Topsham. The new facility would be in Brunswick, Maine. Additionally, as proposed the construction may require the closing of the Montello Manor Nursing Facility in Lewiston. The public hearing will be held on Thursday, December 17th beginning at 1:00 pm until all members of the public in attendance have spoken or 2:30 pm whichever occurs earlier. The Public Hearing will be held by a Department representative in accordance with the provisions of the Maine Certificate of Need Act, as amended (22 MRSA, sec. 103-A).
