CERTIFICATE OF NEED

The following notice is provided in accordance with the Maine Certificate of Need Act (22 M.R.S.A. c.103-A, subsection 339 (2)).

The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), Certificate of Need Unit (CONU), has scheduled a public hearing on Houlton Regional Hospital's proposal to renovate and redesign their Emergency, Nuclear Medicine, Radiology and Cardio/Pulmonary Rehabilitation Departments at their hospital campus located at 20 Hartford Street, Houlton, Maine at an estimated capital cost of \$4,016,240. The public hearing will be held on June 17, 2008 at the John A. Millar Civic Center, Community Room, 94 Randall Avenue, Houlton, Maine starting at 5:00 p.m.

The purpose of this hearing is to allow the Applicant, other directly affected persons and the public to have an opportunity to present information, documentary evidence, arguments, and comments questioning the documentation presented or raise issues and/or concerns to be considered by the Department on this proposal.
