MaineCare now offers a service called Behavioral Health Homes.

The service combines community support and case management with primary care. Mental health providers partner with primary care providers to better manage your care.

Behavioral Health Home services:

- Are voluntary; you join **only if you want to**
- Offer a team approach where care coordination, case management, peer and family supports, and other services work with primary care
- Can take the place of the community support services you receive now
- May already be offered by your/your child's community support provider. Talk to your case manager or community support provider to find out more.
