RE: Application of Johns River Shellfish, LLC for a standard aquaculture lease located in the Johns River in the Town of South Bristol

The decision on the above-named aquaculture standard lease application was signed by the Commissioner on May 18, 2016. This decision is considered the "final agency action" on the application.

Please note that this decision combines the new lease site applied for by Johns River Shellfish (west of Peabow Island) with the company's existing lease in the North Branch of the Johns River, lease JOHN NB2. The resulting lease is named JOHN NB3. See page 14 of the decision for details.
