APPLICATION: Keith Butterfield has applied to the Department of Marine Resources for a limited-purpose (experimental) aquaculture lease on two tracts totaling 3.20 acres located southeast of Moshier Island and southeast of Little Moshier Island, Casco Bay, Yarmouth for suspended culture of American/Eastern oysters and sea scallops. The application, Docket # 2016-11-E, is posted under "Pending Aquaculture Lease Applications" on the Department's website, www.maine.gov/dmr/aquaculture.

COMMENT PERIOD: The Department of Marine Resources announces a **30-day public comment period** during which interested persons may submit written comments or request a public hearing on the application. A hearing is optional for experimental lease applications unless the Department receives five or more written requests from interested persons during the 30-day comment period. A copy of the public notice advertising the comment period is attached. The legal authority for this notice is Title 12, MRSA §6072-A (5) and DMR Rules Chapter 2.64 (4) (C).
