We are just 42 miles North of Freeport. From Rt 295 in Brunswick, take Rt 1 N. to Wiscasset. Turn South on Rt 27 after crossing the bridge. Follow this route until passing the St. Andrews Urgent Care Center. Take a left turn 6/10 of a mile past this, onto McKown Point Road. We are at the end of this road. (GPS: Lat: 43.8439; Long: -69.64)
