Take Rt.1 to Rt. 27 S. Follow signs to Boothbay Harbor. Continue on Rt. 27 past St. Andrew’s Hospital. Take the first left after the hospital (0.6 mi) onto McKown Point Rd. The Aquarium is located at the end of this road.

Closed Mondays & Tuesdays in September.

Closing for season on September 28, 2014.
