Shellfish Harvesting Area Classification-Notification of Changes

November 3, 2015

Ladies and Gentlemen:


Under the authority of Maine statute 12 M.R.S.A., Chapter 607, Section 6172; the Commissioner has made the following change to Area No. 55-B, Southwestern Machias Bay (Machiasport). This notice reopens an area in Bucks Harbor (Machiasport) due to shellfish samples passing fuel contamination testing standards. All existing pollution and red tide/psp closures remain in effect.

The boundary descriptions of the area are as follows (struck text is being removed and underlined text is being added):

- A. Effective immediately, because of pollution, it shall be unlawful to dig, take or possess any clams, quahogs, oysters or mussels from the shores, flats and waters of the following Prohibited area(s): Howard Cove and Starboard Cove (Machiasport): west of a line beginning at a red-painted post located at the top of the Jasper Beach natural seawall, approximately 336 yards west of the entrance to the Jasper Beach salt pond, then running southwest to the south tip of an unnamed point of land at the southeast mouth of Howard Cove, then continuing southwest to the south tip of the point of land at the northeast mouth of Starboard Creek where it enters into Starboard Cove.
- ~~1. Howard Cove and Starboard Cove (Machiasport): west of a line beginning at a red-painted post located at the top of the Jasper Beach natural seawall, approximately 336 yards west of the entrance to the Jasper Beach salt pond, then running southwest to the south tip of an unnamed point of land at the southeast mouth of Howard Cove, then continuing southwest to the south tip of the point of land at the northeast mouth of Starboard Creek where it enters into Starboard Cove.~~
- ~~2. Bucks harbor and vicinity (Machiasport) west of a line starting at the south west tip of Mountain Head (Machiasport) and running southeast to the west tip of Bar Island (Machiasport) and then running southeast to the north tip of Pettegrow Point (Machiasport).~~
- D. Effective immediately, because of seasonal pollution, it shall be unlawful to dig, take or possess any clams, quahogs, oysters or mussels from the shores, flats and waters of the following Conditionally Approved area(s) during the closed dates: Bucks Harbor (Machiasport): west of a line beginning at the northeastern most tip of Bucks Neck (Machiasport) and running northeast to the south tip of Mountain Head (Machiasport). This area has been classified as "Conditionally Approved" and it shall be closed from September 1 to October 31.
