11/10/2015	4/1/2016	Ogunquit River, eastern shore: starting from the eastern end of the Ocean Street footbridge, and running southerly to a point of land* on the eastern shore that is due east of a red painted post located on the western shore at the end of Green Needle Lane. (* point of land Lat/Lon – 43 deg 15' 16.2" N / 70 deg 35' 39.2" W)	Closed
