1/1/2023	7/1/2023	Southern Three Brooks - From the northern most point of Long Point	Closed
		to the northern most point of Hemlock Island to Scott Perry's ramp	
		and east to the southeastern most point of Green Point – all the	
		shores and flats southeast of this line.	
7/1/2023	12/31/2023	Bray Ledge Area: From the Northwestern most point of Upper	Closed
		Wass Cove the line follows the main drain from shore to the	
		middle of the mussel bed then turns East to the middle of the	
		Pleasant River. The line then follows the middle of the Pleasant	
		River North to a point perpendicular to the Northeastern most	
		point of Upper Wass Cove. The line then turns West to said	
		point.	
7/1/2023	12/31/2023	Northern Pleasant River: Starting at the Southeastern most point	Closed
		of Green Point a line goes West towards Scott Perry's ramp in	
		Harrington to the town line in the Pleasant River. This line then	
		follows the middle of the Pleasant River North until it gets to a	
		point perpendicular to the first point above Knowles Brook.	
		The line then turns east to said point.	
7/1/2022	12/31/2023	Seal Cove: From the Southwestern most point of Seavey Point a line	Closed
		extends to the Western most point of Gibbs island. Then from the	
		Southwestern most point of Gibbs Island to an unnamed ledge South	
		of Gibbs island then turning East and ending at the Northwestern	
		most point of Tumbledown Dick Cove.	
7/1/2022	12/31/2023	Southern West River: A line starting on the Southern side of the West	Closed
		River Landing extends East out to the center of the West River. The	
		line then goes South following the middle of the West River to a point	
		perpendicular to the Southwestern most point of Bickford Point. The	
		line then goes to said point.
