Licenses may be issued starting on April 15, 2024, following a minimum of 10 days advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C.

*A minimum 10% of the number of resident licenses sold in each license category must be made available to nonresidents in that license category. If more than 100 commercial resident licenses are sold, additional commercial nonresident licenses will need to be sold to meet the 10% minimum.
