Requirements for School Psychologist Certificate (093)

You will be eligible for a conditional certificate in Maine upon completion of Section A and Section B.

If you complete all requirements, you will be issued a three year professional certificate.

Section A:
One of the following: (1) valid National Certified School Psychologist certificate issued by the National School Psychology Certification Board; (2) graduate degree in school psychology from an accredited program approved by NCATE/NASP; (3) valid license issued by the Maine Board of Examiners of Psychologists; or (4) completion of all requirements in the transcript analysis pathway #4 as described in rule Chapter 115, Part II.
Section B:
Two recommendations from licensed or certified providers of school psychological services who have reviewed the professional work you have provided.
Section C:
Satisfactory completion of required supervision during the first year of independent practice as a school psychologist (special documentation forms to be enclosed with the issued certificate).
Section D:
Criminal history record check approval – based on fingerprints
