Requirements for the Athletic Director Certificate (215)

You will be issued a a two-year provisional certificate if you complete Section A.

SECTION A:
1. Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution
2. Criminal history record check approval – based on fingerprints

Upon the renewal of your first five year professional certificate, you must submit documentation of completion of Section A. or Section B. below as well as complete any other renewal requirements for a professional certificate.

SECTION A:
Holds valid Maine administrator certificate (other than a Teaching Principal [057] certificate)
SECTION B:
1. Interscholastic Athletics: Philosophy, Organization, and Programs
2. Athletic Administration: Principles, Strategies, and Methods
3. Athletic Administration: Legal Issues

If this requirements list is more than two years old, please contact the certification office, as the requirements may have changed.

A provisional certificate is issued to an applicant who has met all of the requirements but has not taught for two school years in a Maine school with a Professional Learning Community Support System (PLCSS). Once an applicant has taught for two school years in a Maine school and been recommended for a five-year certificate by the local school district's PLCSS, the full five-year certificate will be issued.
