Major Capital School Construction

The Administrative Review periods for both the Major Capital School Construction Program and the Integrated, Consolidated 9-16 Educational Facility have now been completed. There were no appeals submitted for either program after the State Board of Education's acceptance of the Proposed Priority Lists at its June 13th meeting. The next step will be for the Commissioner to recommend to the State Board of Education the Final Priority Lists. It is anticipated that will occur at the August 14th Board meeting.
