MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Fiscal Year (FY) 2024, Maine Army National Guard Critical Information List

1. Reference. AR 530-1, paragraph 2-19.
2. Purpose. The Maine Army National Guard (MEARNG) Critical Information List (CIL) outlines controlled unclassified information (CUI) items that detail organizational capabilities, activities, limitations, and intentions. The CIL guides decision making and risk management for MEARNG commanders, directors, staff, and leaders at all echelons in the organization. Providing wide dissemination ensures the CIL is understood and protected by all personnel assigned to or supporting the MEARNG.
3. Critical Information List. Items produced in the following categories fall under the purview of the MEARNG CIL:
  - a. Operations. Details including but not limited to schedules, routes, movements, plans, policies, and command courses of action.
  - b. Forces. MEARNG units earmarked for possible courses of action, current or future locations of key leaders, personnel rosters, personal identifiable information (PII), and personnel readiness metrics.
  - c. Supply and Logistics. Logistical posture of MEARNG units, speed of deployment/redeployment of units, limitations to resupply capabilities, and critical item shortages (all classes).
  - d. Communications. Location and information of command, control, communications, computers, intelligence capabilities, and locations of sensitive communication facilities.
  - e. Vulnerabilities. Vulnerabilities in resource protection, funding shortfalls and capabilities, mission essential vulnerable areas (MEVAs), access control systems, security forces, or security plans.
  - f. Contract Activity. Contractor increasing hiring for new or existing contracts or programs and contractor information or service-sharing agreements with other private organizations.
